**W**ith some of the beginning of 1956 here we realize our under construction three (3) new deepwater ice breakers and one (1) Ice Hull Oil Tank in the drawing stage, all of which are under contract for the United States Maritime Administration.

Future business opportunities appear brighter at the present time as there will be several prospective ships that we will be engaged to build in during this year. Management is hoping, in order to obtain new work for the year, that our units will be brought down sufficiently to meet the highly competitive field in which we find ourselves. For successful operation this year must have sufficient volume of work to maintain a crew of approximately four thousand to include bonded employees. If this goal could be reached our future position would become very much improved.

The company feels through more individual effort on the part of each of us and finally cooperation between management and employees, that this goal can be brought back to its former competitive position and sufficient work obtained to keep us busy.

I extend to all of you and your families my best wishes for a Happy and Prosperous New Year.

## A MESSAGE FROM THE TREASURER



**T**he work of our fellow workmen and their families, I wish to extend my best wishes for good health, happiness and prosperity during the coming year.

The officers and management of the Company were pleased that the Company was awarded the contract to build the Ice-Breaker Cargo Ship (Shell Ice-Breaker)

all of it for the Navy, under the supervision of the Maritime Administration in addition to our present contract for three Navy Icebreakers. At the end of 1955 the number of employees on the payroll was over 300 higher than the end of 1954. The increase in employment is encouraging, and we hope that our 1956 will reflect a higher picture.

We all have a common interest in the success of the Company in securing the necessary volume of business to maintain our present employment and to provide jobs for as many new employees as our facilities permit. Each and every employee plays an important role in producing our product, and we must work together as a team for the Company in a competitive position and keep it there.

The Company has always been interested in the well being of its employees and their families and continues steadily to take the most benefit plans for its employees, with new and excellent insurance and hospitalization and medical insurance. On November 28, 1955 the Company negotiated an increase in the daily benefits for hospitalization for employees and dependents from \$100 to \$125 a day, and to increase the allowance for extra charges from \$1000 to \$12500 at an additional cost to the employees, and also negotiated after employee consultation their work with the Company, the principle of increasing their hospitalization and medical group policies to individual policies.

Effective January 1, 1956 the Company will increase its weekly contribution to the Ice Ship Mutual Benefit Assn.

ation from life to the tax each member employee, the increase in the weekly contribution will be made by the employer.

The administration of the insurance plans is a responsibility of the Department under the Treasurer, and the New Ship Mutual Benefit Association is administered by a Board of Directors, which consists of various employees of the Company who voluntarily give their time to attending weekly meetings held after working hours. Their work is highly appreciated.

The Group Hospitalization and Hospital Expense Insurance, covering employees and dependents for hospitalization resulting from sickness and accidents, paid benefits of \$4,000.00 to 200 employees, an average of \$20.00 per year, and benefits of \$2,000.00 for 200 dependents of employees, an average of \$10.00 per year during the past year.

The Group Life Insurance paid benefits of \$200,000.00 to the families of 20 employees during the past twelve months, which averaged \$10,000.00 per year. New Ship's group life insurance plan is one of the best in the country. The employee receives insurance protection while in the employ of the Company based on their annual earnings, which is calculated by multiplying their hourly rate by 100, representing the approximate normal work hours in a year. The Company pays for the first \$2,000 of insurance in full, and a substantial part of the premium on the balance of the insurance.

The Company cooperates with the Government in accumulating the systematic purchase of Government Savings Bonds, and in addition pays all the desired expense involved. During 1959 the employees purchased \$98,772.00 maturity valued Saving Bonds.

The New Ship Mutual Benefit Association, which paid out benefits of \$90.00 a week during 1959, paid out a total of \$4,000.00 to 200 employees during the past year, an average of \$20.00 per year. As the result of increased weekly contributions from the employees and the Company, the Directors of the Association have voted to increase the weekly benefits from \$100.00 to \$120.00 per week, effective January 1, 1960.

We all look forward to going through the year ahead without having to take advantage of the benefits provided by the sick or hospitalization plans, but we cannot all be so fortunate, and the existence of such plans enable us to face the future with feeling of security.

Let us hope 1960 will be a better year for all of us.
