THE ANTI-CAPITALIST MENTALITY

There is a general aversion of capitalists toward the people who defend it as the economic system providing the greatest material abundance for more people than all the other and planned systems. I suspect that much of this aversion comes from people who fail to appreciate the conviction that the success of capitalism depends on individual competition, as a basis of morality, in an atmosphere of freedom. Freedom exists when the system recognizes and respects the natural rights of each.

This truth is brought out in a new book, "The Anti-Capitalist Mentality", by Ludwig Von Mises.

For those readers not familiar with some economic writers, we might mention that von Mises is not only one of the greatest living economists, but also a qualified philosopher in human relations.

In his small, highly readable book we found what seems to be the answer.

Von Mises writes "In a society based on work, status or rank, an individual's status in life is fixed. He is born into a certain status, and his position in society is rigidly determined by the laws and customs which assign to each member of his rank definite privileges and duties or definite disabilities."

From this general principle von Mises goes on to the main scope of his book: "In a society based on work and status, the individual can neither improve his or condition toward his own control. He is a slave because superhuman powers had assigned him this work. It is not his doing, and there is no reason for him to be ashamed of his condition. He only wishes that death would end his misery. If the way we will have "Why are you not a duke?" If you were a duke, I would be a duke," he would reply: "If I had been born the son of a duke, I would not have remained poor, a slave girl, but the daughter of another duke, that you are not a duke is exclusively your own fault, why were you not

more above in the choice of your parents?"

It is quite another thing under capitalism. Here everybody's status in life depends on his own doing. Everybody whose activities have not been fully qualified knows very well that he has several chances, that he has been tried and found wanting by the better ones. If his wife reproaches him: "Why do you make only eight dollars a week? If you were as smart as your former girl, Paul, you would be a duke and I would enjoy a better life," the business conviction of his own individuality and free individualism."

In contrast the longings were that social systems which do not transfer individual liberty and self-determination, furnish either for personal failure, while under the freedom of competitive private capitalism, failures have no one to blame but themselves.

As an explanation of why some Americans hate the distribution way of life, this writer goes even deeper than anything that we have read on this subject, because it explains the fatal increasing prejudice that characterizes the people who want to change America into a country where people will not be allowed to fail--not to succeed.

It also explains, we believe, why this prejudice is inevitable. For those people "disappointed of success" it is a dearest wish--one essential to their self-respect and to many more, without it their lives would probably be unbearable.

Even though these people represent a small minority they spread their poison to millions of other people.

Fortunately, however, this prejudice is normal people is unstable. It requires quality to small doses of thought control gone.

But the task of reconstructing the poison is an endless one, because there are millions more of these individuals. We believe, therefore, von Mises' new book is a valuable addition to an educational body of literature.
